

College Student Registers .341 on Breathalyzer



Samantha Lynne Goudie did learned her lesson after a breathalyzer test registered her blood alcohol content at .341.

The drunken co-ed live-tweeted her arrest with surprising coherence after a football game between Northern Illinois and Iowa.

Goudie, 22, of Iowa City, jumped a stadium barrier and tried to run onto the field. Police officers arrested and charged her with public intoxication, giving her a breathalyzer test in jail. Amazingly, the young co-ed registered a blood alcohol content level of .341 — more than four times the .08 BAC drunk driving limit.
